## Global Citizen USA

## Gasparilla Island & Spokes of Hope

Gasparilla Island Volunteer Fire Department was impacted by Hurricane Ian. As Spokes of Hope was working in the area to rebuild 40 - 50 homes, they connected FEMA HQ Donations with the Fire Department.

Around the same time, Alletess Medical Laboratory offered FEMA HQ Donations a new 48kw generator. The team matched the generator to the Volunteer Fire Department which enabled them to resume services and the community to save additional expenses. This resulted in a stronger relationship built with the nonprofit.
